


# Art & Tech Swiss tour Start Zurich - End Geneva

#### Basel - Bern - Lausanne Architecture & Art

In Basel discover the Beyeler fondation: An uplifting experience right from the start. The aesthetically pleasing construction by the Italian architect Renzo Piano surrounded by an idyllic park with trees and sculptures on the green carpet of grass exude a contagious, peaceful mood.

But even inside the Fondation Beyeler building you meet with a relaxed atmosphere. The 250 masterpieces of the Hildy and Ernst Beyeler collection enjoy plenty of space in bright rooms – with part of the ground floor reserved for high-profile temporary exhibitions – with artists such as Marlene Dumas, Gerhard Richter or Ferdinand Hodler.

Continue your tour towards Bern where you will visit the Zentrum Paul Klee: With about 4,000 paintings (40% of his oeuvre) by the famous painter Paul Klee, the Zentrum Paul Klee houses the largest collection of its kind. The unusual building has a wave-like structure and was designed by the Italian architect Renzo Piano. Apart from art exhibitions, the Zentrum Paul Klee also offers a platform for music, theatre, dance and literature.

# Lausanne Rolex Center - Geneva Bio Tech Campus & Red Cross Museum

Art and Technology meet in today's visit. The Rolex Learning Center is a real feat of technological innovation and is home to a vast research library, training, catering and exhibition areas - all on the shores of Lake Geneva. The new, airy, bright Information Centre of the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne with its curved lines is a delightful example of modern architecture.

Continue your tour to discover two innovative locations in Geneva: the Red Cross Museum and the BioTech Campus.

Emotion, discovery, reflection: the Red Cross Museum offers you a unique opportunity to enter into the history of humanitarian action. Three separate areas, each developed by a well-known exhibition architect, allow you to explore three major challenges in today's world: Defending human dignity, Restoring family links, Reducing natural risks.

Campus Biotech is a Swiss center of excellence in biotechnology and life sciences research focusing on three domains: Neuroscience & Neurotechnology, Digital Health and Global Health.

The building integrates environmental principles into its architectural design - been heated in winter and cooled in summer by using water from Lake Geneva.
